Gatwick Greenspace will be working in Great Turners Wood and the Meadow next to it on Highland Road.

**Meeting at front entrance at 09:45 until approximately 14.30pm each day.**

Cllr Michelle Watson has been working with Gatwick Greenspace and Mole Valley Council to allow work to be done within Great Turners Wood. For the last 2 years MVDC has been unable to get machinery in the meadow or Woodlands because it was simply too wet.

In October I'm hoping that MVDC will be able to get into the meadow and woodlands to cut the grass along the butterfly flight path and cut the glade to remove the brambles that have taken over.

Then Kevin from Gatwick Greenspace will come in on the dates shown above to thin out the trees and coppicing along woodland ride and path edges/cutting back path next to the front "meadow" and willow coppicing on front meadow (with a small bonfire to clear arisings if dry enough). The willows on the meadow will be cut approximately 1m tall to allow easier removal of roots by contractors provided by Mole Valley Council afterwards.
