- Steve Killick has a quote from Mr E. Kendall to repaint the village hall: All windows and doors to cleaned off. Walls to be jet washed, take all loose paint off, filled where needed, then a coat of stabiliser round all walls, then painted with 2 coats of **either** :
 1. white sandtex £4400, or

2. There is a masonry paint which is oil based which is longer lasting and can be jet washed if it gets dirty and won't wash or flake or spoliate off like Sandtex, that costs more and would be £4900
3. The brown clerestory panels to have new panels on top then sealed to make waterproof then painted same colour all the way round two coats price £ 950
